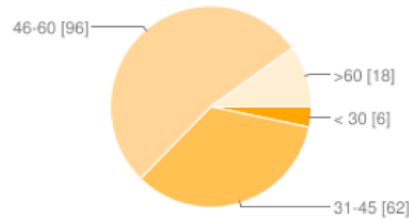

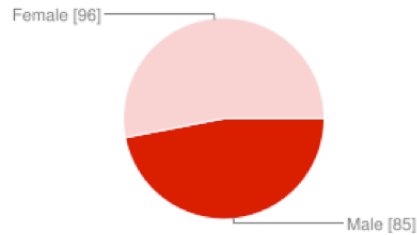

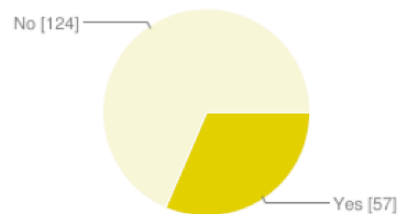

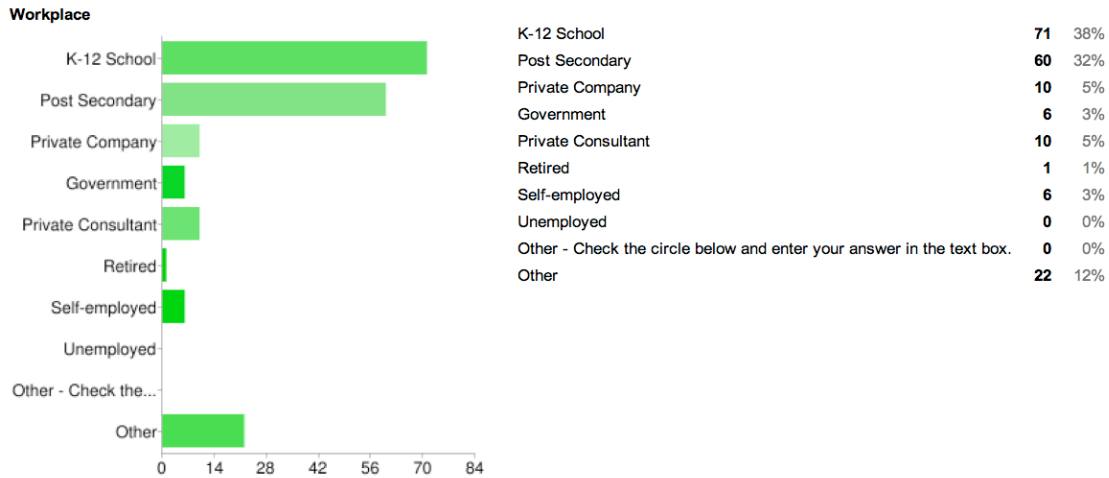

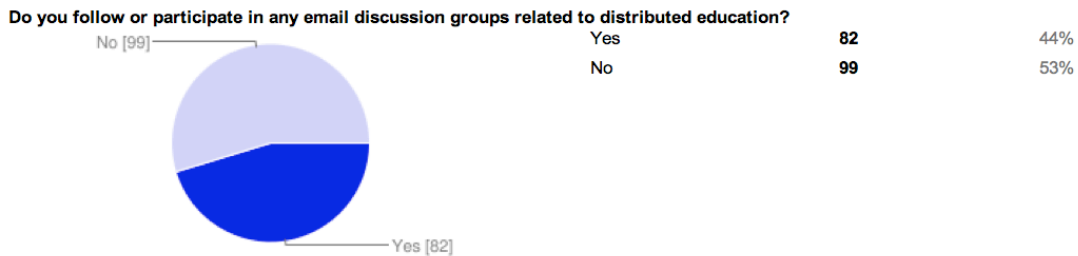

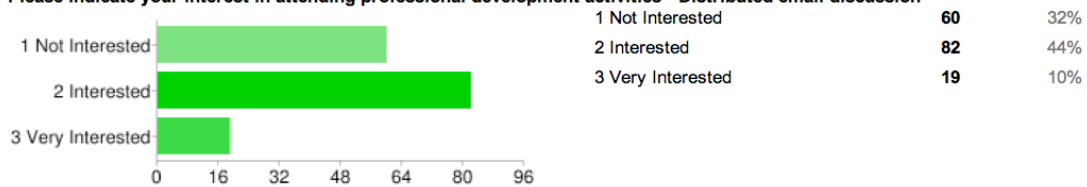

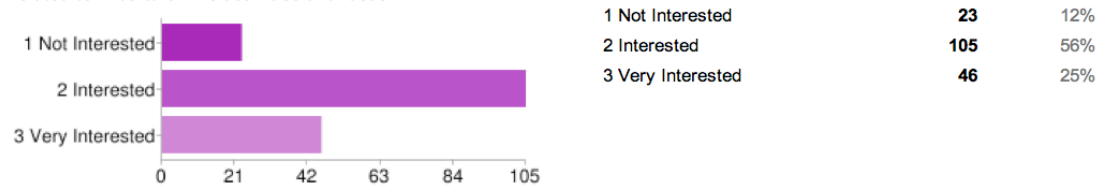


Please indicate your interest in attending professional development activities - Distributed email discussion

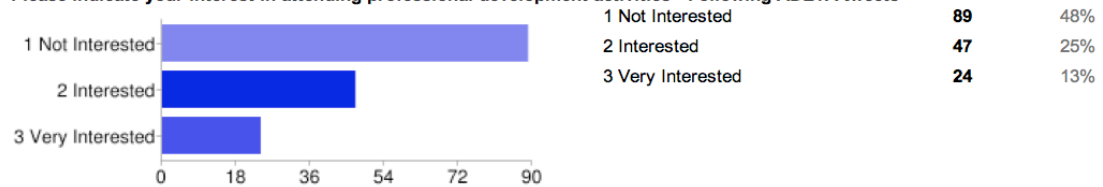

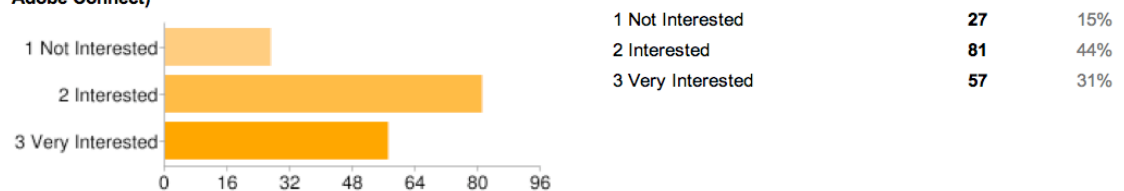

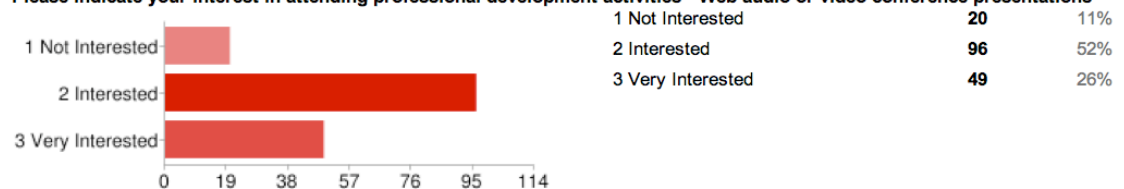

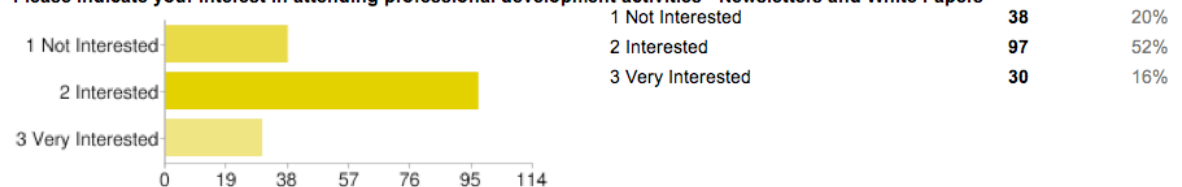

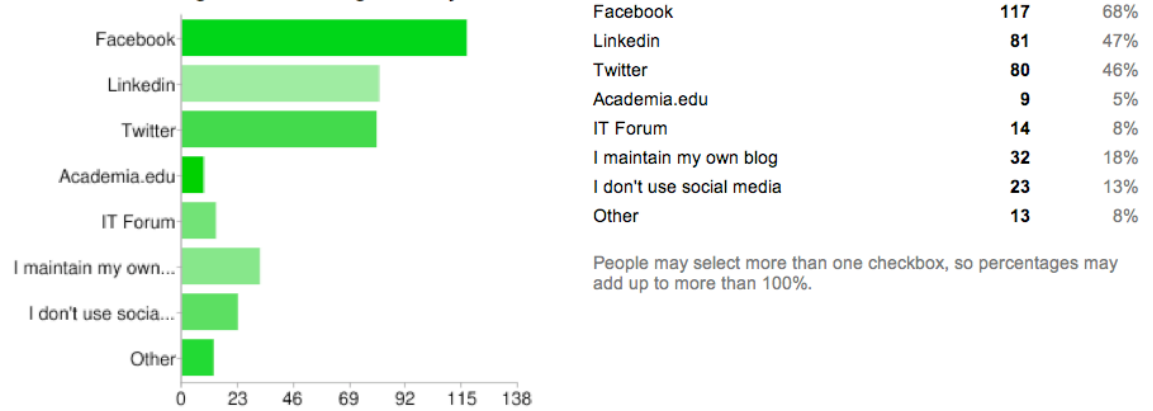

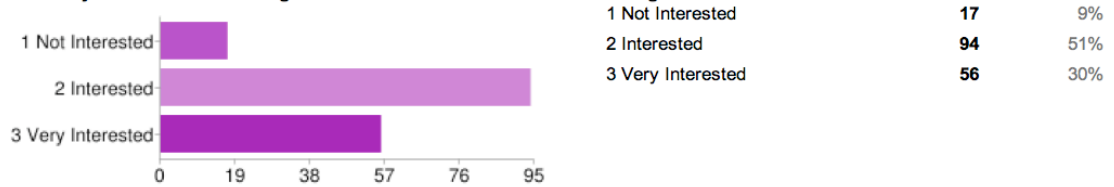

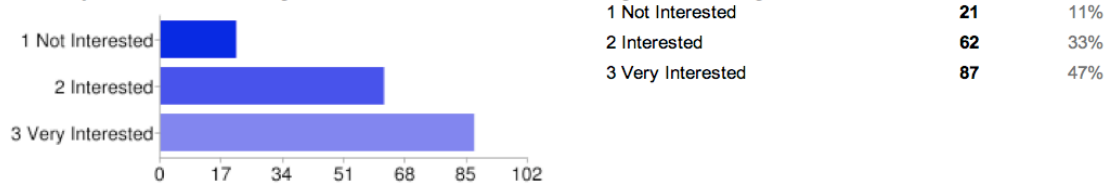
Which of the following social networking tools do you use?



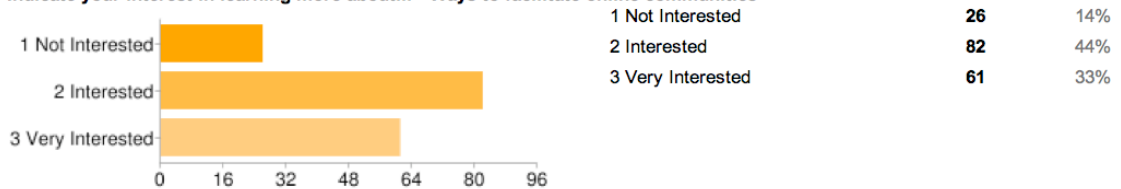

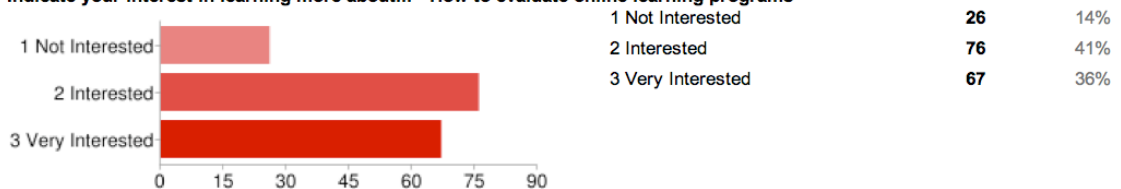
Indicate your interest in learning more about... - New instructional designs and learning activities for distance learners

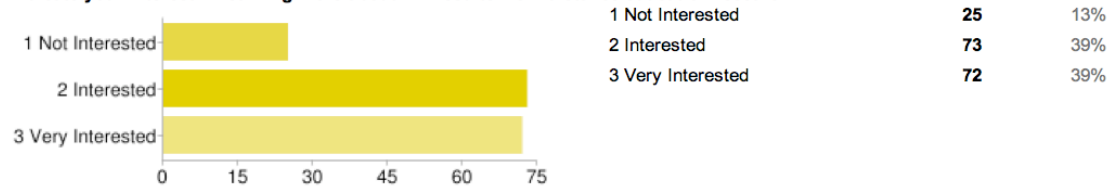


Indicate your interest in learning more about... - How to evaluate online learning programs

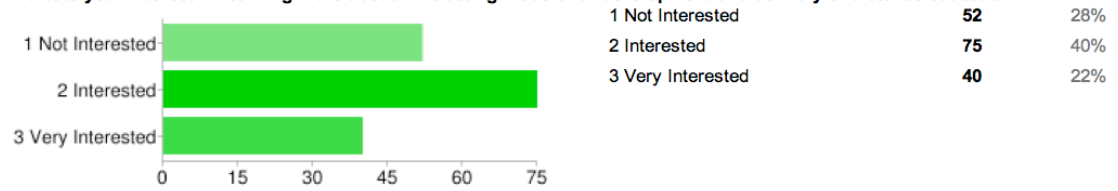

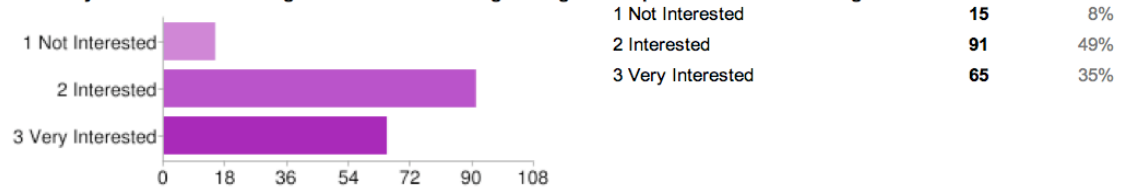
Indicate your interest in learning more about... - Results from distance education research



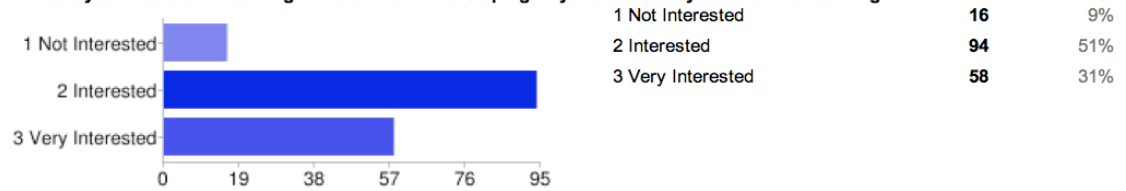
Indicate your interest in learning more about... - Costing models for development and delivery of distance education



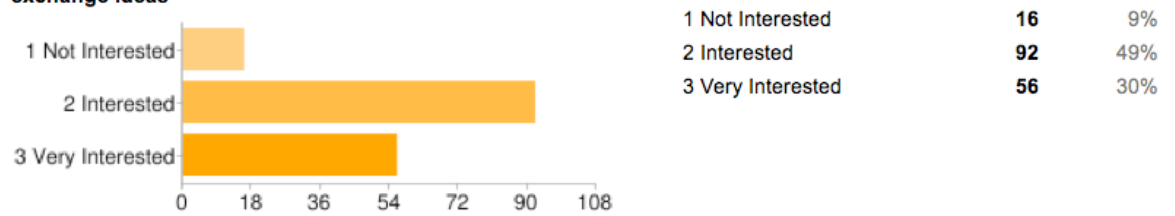

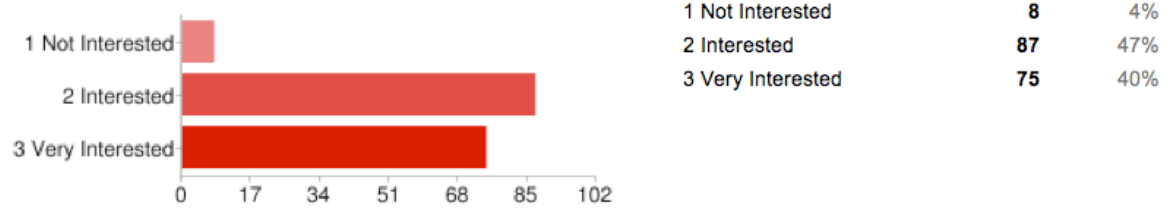

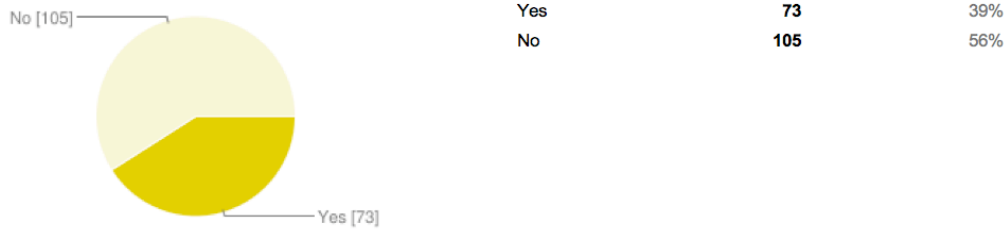

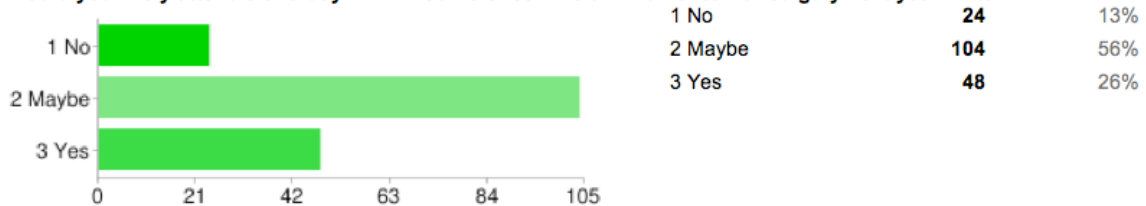

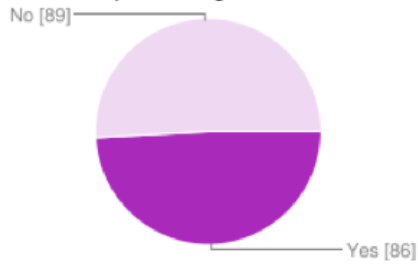

Would you likely attend a two-day ADETA conference if held in Edmonton or Calgary next year? - Item 1



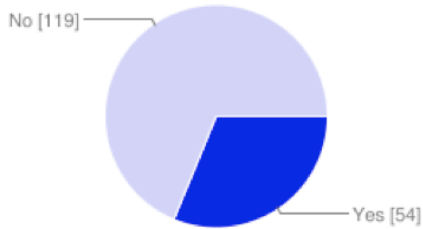

Would you consider purchasing a \$100 annual ADETA membership?



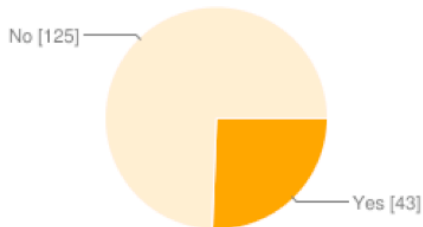
